

Application for THE ARFTG MICROWAVE MEASUREMENT STUDENT FELLOWSHIP

- I. The applicant should prepare a document (in pdf format) covering the following items:
 1. Applicant's name, e-mail address, home address, and phone number
 2. Technical background of applicant
Include a brief biographical sketch, including degrees already received, professional positions held and a list of publications (2 pages maximum)
 3. Degree program currently pursued full-time by applicant
Name of university and research group, degree sought (Master or PhD in EE, Physics, ...), and expected completion date
 5. Faculty advisor's or supervisor's name, e-mail address, and phone number
 6. (in case faculty advisor or supervisor is not an ARFTG member) Endorsing ARFTG member's name, e-mail address, and phone number
 7. Description of proposed research project to be funded
*(to be prepared by student, with assistance from faculty advisor or supervisor)
State the objectives of the proposed work, include a description of the work plan, list the expected outcome, and explain how the proposed work relates to the applicant's degree program (3 pages maximum)*
 8. Include a brief description of laboratory facilities available to support the RF/microwave measurement work *(1 page maximum)*
- II. The applicant is responsible to ensure that his/her faculty advisor or supervisor prepares the following document and submits it prior to the deadline to the ARFTG Fellowship coordinator:
 1. Faculty advisor's or supervisor's name, e-mail address, and phone number
 2. Letter of reference for the applicant
 3. A budget explaining how the funds are intended to be allocated between stipend, supplies and travel, taking into account the ARFTG Fellowship rules
 4. Professional background information, including a list of up to five recent publications *(2 pages maximum)*
- III. In case the faculty advisor or supervisor is not an ARFTG member, the applicant is also responsible to obtain the endorsement from an ARFTG member, and to ask this person to write a letter of reference and submit it to the ARFTG Fellowship Coordinator prior to the deadline.
