

ARFTG By-laws

The ARFTG By-laws are an important document describing how the organization operates and an amendment to the document requires approval of the general membership. The document was originally created in 2000 and it was felt that there were some changes that would benefit the organization. These changes are in the areas of allowing for more modern means of communication within the executive committee and with the general membership, removal of anachronisms (e.g., telegraph for communication), clarifications of potentially ambiguous clauses and correction of typographical errors. The redlined document shows the proposed changes along with explanatory comments (the comments will not be part of the final document if approved). A vote on the proposed changes is scheduled during the business meeting at the next ARFTG conference (January 21-22, 2019 in Orlando, FL).
